



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport
(Alexandria, Egypt)**

And

**THE UNIVERSITY OF BRADFORD
(Bradford, UK)**

This Memorandum of Understanding (henceforth MoU) is drawn up to provide a basis on which the Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport (henceforth AASTMT) and the University of Bradford, UK (henceforth UoB) may establish formal relationship specifically designed to promote the internationalization of higher education in Egypt and cultural co-operation between Egypt and the UK. The MoU seeks to develop and strengthen the bonds between the two academic communities and in the process also contribute to generate understanding, cooperation and communication between the two cultures.

This MoU is intended to provide a basis on which formal agreements may be drawn up between the two parties in accordance with and under the terms of UoB's Academic Quality Handbook and arrangements for the Management of Higher Education with Partners, to regulate the academic, financial, administrative, practical and other arrangements for the following proposed areas:-

- Staff development and exchange
- Student exchange
- Recognition agreements
- Articulation agreements
- Joint teaching programmes
- Joint research programmes

The cooperation in any specific area will be subject to availability of funds and mutual agreement by the Universities. The intention is that a formal agreement will be drawn up and signed by both AASTMT and UoB after deliberation and approval by the appropriate and competent authorities of both parties.

This MoU has been drawn up and will be implemented in good faith. It expresses the hope and intention of the undersigning institutions to develop cooperation, based on mutual respect and understanding. The MoU will be effective for an initial period of two years from the date of the signatures. The agreement may be terminated by either university giving at least three months written notice to the other.
